In the 116-year history of Residing Hope, formerly Florida United Methodist Children's Home. this is our fourth name change. In 1908 we started as the Florida Methodist Orphanage. In the 1930s, realization was made that we were serving few orphans and more children who had been abused. neglected and abandoned so the name was changed to Florida Methodist Children's Home. With the formation of the UMC in 1968 and merge with the Sarah Hunt Home, we became the Florida United Methodist Children's Home in 1971, and now we are Residing Hope.

We unveiled our new name - Residing Hope - and our new logo.
